Jim Donnelly, Jason Gallagher, and Reggie Holt took care of renting two minivans and bringing them over to us so we would have transportation while we were there and be able to get back home.

There are times when we simply can't make it without the assistance of others. The support that these friends of mine have given me in the past few weeks has caused me to see this even more clearly. The love and support of a Christian family is not a thing to take for granted. Help someone today...it will mean so much to them!
