**Now, How Does That Go?**

I recently read an article that showed the results a first grade teacher in Michigan got when she gave her class a list of the first half of well-known proverbs and asked the students to complete them. Some of the results are great! Here are a few examples:

- “Strike while the..... bug is close.”
- “If you lie down with dogs, you'll..... stink in the morning.”
- “Children should be seen and not..... spanked or grounded.”
- “When the blind lead the blind..... get out of the way.”
- “Laugh and the whole world laughs with you, cry and..... you have to blow your nose.”
- “Love all, trust..... me.”
- “Don't bite the hand that..... looks dirty.”

These weren't correct, but they either made sense, or are humorous.

How frequently would we find ourselves in the place of one of these first grade students when trying to complete well-known Bible verses? How would we fare with teaching the simple truth of the gospel to someone? Sure, we may be able to give a seemingly logical explanation, but would it be correct?

Psalms and Proverbs are rife with encouragements to seek knowledge. Peter, in 2 Peter 1:5-8, includes knowledge among a list of qualities that help us to be fruitful. The Hebrew writer, in Hebrews 5:11-14, teaches that we must grow in our faith and knowledge. We don't have to look very hard to find the importance of an ever-increasing knowledge of God and His will in Scripture!

Could we tell someone about the Bible? Could we tell someone about Christ and His sacrifice for us? If our knowledge is holding us back, there is no excuse, and we are the only ones responsible! Just like the kids' song says, “Read your Bible, pray every day, and you'll grow, grow, grow.” Let's be those people!
