**The Blessing of Fellowship**

This past weekend, we had our annual Family Retreat at Camp Meribah. There were over 80 people there on Saturday and 60 that attended for the entire weekend. There are many things that I love about this weekend, but it all boils down to being able to spend time with my church family in fellowship with one another.

Fellowship is a gift that God has given us, and His Word has a great deal to say about it. Let's take the time to consider just a few verses.

*"Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ."* – Galatians 6:2. According to this verse, part of fellowship involves helping those that are dealing with problems. But, how can we help others with the problems they are facing if we don't know that they are having problems? Because of this, I believe that we can find a couple of implications from this verse. First, we have to be actively involved in the lives of one another so that we know the things that are happening in each other's lives, and, second, we have to be willing to share our problems with each other. Fellowship helps us get through the things that life brings our way!

*"For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ."* – 1 Corinthians 12:12. We all play different roles in the body of Christ. But, we must work together in order for the body to be able to function properly. In this way, fellowship aids us in accomplishing what the church is supposed to do. When we spend time together, we learn the strengths of one another and are able to maximize our potential in reaching the lost!

*"And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, the breaking of bread, and in prayers."* – Acts 2:42. According to the pattern of the New Testament church, we are to continue spending time with those that have more experience and knowledge than we do. This, obviously, allows us to learn from them.

This is by no means all that the Bible has to say about fellowship, but I believe it gives us a good picture of the important role that it plays in the life of a Christian. Fellowship is important. It challenges us, encourages us, helps us stay accountable, and shows obedience to the pattern of the New Testament. Take advantage of the blessing of fellowship!
