Christ-like Service
(Part 3)

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus said, "Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven" (Matt. 6:1). What, if anything, does this have to say about the service that we render to others?

The word "righteousness" in this verse is of a general character, which basically sums up the demands of God: "to do right" (Acts 10:35; 1 John 2:29; 3:7, 10; Rev. 22:11). Doing right would certainly include serving our fellow man (Matt. 20:26; John 13:14-15; Gal. 5:13).

Jesus stresses the fact that our acts of righteousness should not proceed from improper motives. Indeed, motives often determine the quality of our actions (cf. 1 Cor. 13:1-3). Consider the fact that a kiss may be an act of love, or it may be an act of betrayal (cf. Mark 14:44-46). Unfortunately, many of the religious leaders of Jesus' day were in the business of impressing men (Matt. 23:5; John 5:44; 12:42-43). Jesus makes it clear that their "reward" is the praise of men, and nothing more is due them.

For all intents and purposes, Christ-like service is content with hiddenness. It needs no human applause. In fact, when we render service to others, our motive in doing so should be to bring glory to God and not ourselves (Matt. 5:16). We serve others to point them to the Christ who served the world by laying down His life for the world (Mark 10:45).
