Start with the Heart

All of you who are reading this article have a heart, i.e. a blood-pumping organ with two ventricles and two atriums that resides in the left side of your chest. I don't think I have to tell you how vital your heart is, but I will anyway. If your heart stops beating, you die. Consequently, doctors and loved ones regularly remind you to pay attention to your heart and take care of it.

Now, as important as your physical heart may be, you actually have another heart that is arguably more important. It is that invisible part of you that philosophers, poets, and preachers refer to all the time. It is that part of you that is truly you. Jesus says that everything that comes out of you, i.e. words and actions, proceeds from your heart (Matt. 15:18-20; Mark 7:20-23). So, if what's coming out of you is bad or evil, then the heart of the problem is a problem of the heart.

For the next few months on Sunday mornings in the adult auditorium class, I will be administering what we might refer to as a "spiritual arteriogram." It is not enough to monitor our behavior; we must learn to monitor our hearts. In fact, Proverbs 4:23 states, "Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life." In other words, the most important thing is to guard the most important thing.

Echoing David's prayer in Psalm 51:10, my prayer for this series of lessons is that God will create in all of us a clean heart. A healthy spiritual life requires a healthy spiritual heart. Thus, we all need to be challenged to rid our hearts of things like envy, greed, guilt, anger, pride, ingratitude, impatience, fear, prejudice, etc. Please consider joining me at 9:30 a.m. this Sunday morning for the first lesson in the series entitled "Start with the Heart."
