You Are Not Alone

Have you ever felt forlorn? That's not a word we use much, but it speaks to a feeling of abandonment, loneliness, and even hopelessness. Circumstances arise on occasion that leave us feeling forlorn, such as the death of a loved one, the displacement of a beloved family member or friend, or the loss of a job. In times like these, we need to be reminded that we are not alone.

After His resurrection and before His ascension, Jesus made a statement that we should hold close to our hearts: "And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matt. 28:20b). Doubtless these words would have been comforting to those chosen apostles who would carry on Jesus' mission in the world, but they also constitute a promise to those of us who follow Jesus today. Jesus wants you and me to know that we are never really alone, because He is with us (cf. John 14:23; Rom. 8:31-39).

In Hebrews 13:5-6, we find a quotation of both Joshua 1:5 and Psalm 118:6 that the Hebrews writer used to comfort his Christian readers: "[God] will never leave you nor forsake you.' So we can confidently say, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me'" (cf. Ps. 23:4; Isa. 41:10). God's original promise to Joshua still rings true for His people today.

Furthermore, despite whatever anxieties may arise in our hearts, we know that God stands ready to bear those anxieties: "Humble yourselves therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you" (1 Pet. 5:6-7; cf. Matt. 6:25-34). Interestingly enough, humbling ourselves before God involves depending on God to help us with what concerns us most.

When you feel forlorn, look to the Lord. Though you may not be able to see Him with your physical eyes, you can see Him through the eyes of faith, trusting that He is near and that He cares for you.
