**BEING A GOOD EXAMPLE**

A rather humorous story is told of a man who used his seven-year-old son's baseball bat to break up the thick coat of ice that had settled on his driveway after a heavy storm. He eventually got cold and went inside for a cup of coffee before attempting to clear the car. Several minutes later, his son who had been outside with him walked into the house.

"Dad," he said, "I got the ice off the car."

"How in the world did you do that?" his father asked.

"Same way you did," the boy shrugged, "with the baseball bat."

Whether or not we are conscious of it or choose to accept it, we are all setting an example for someone. Sons look up to their fathers. Daughters look up to their mothers. Younger siblings look up to older siblings. New converts attach themselves to more mature ones. For better or worse, we are constantly influencing others through our words and actions.

The apostle Paul was aware of this dynamic and wrote the following words to a young evangelist: "[S]et the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity" (1 Tim. 4:12). Paul's reasoning behind this admonition is found in vs. 16: "Keep a close watch on yourself and on the teaching. Persist in this, for by so doing you will save both yourself and your hearers." In Paul's estimation, maintaining a good example serves two very important purposes: (1.) saving oneself; (2.) saving others. Christians, of all people, should understand the necessity and power of a good example. As such, let us resolve to be the people that Jesus has called us to be before a watching world (Matt. 5:14-16; Phil. 2:14-16; 1 Pet. 2:11-12).
