### Lesson and Scripture

### Applications

1. Day of Pentecost  
Acts 2

The church is made up of Christians who are striving to obey God's will. Also, stress that it is through the Word that God's spirit guides us today.

2. Lame Man at Gate  
Acts 3:1-10

Stress the Power of God.

3. The Church Increases  
Annas & Caiphas Speak  
To Peter and John  
Acts 3:11-26; Acts 4:1-22

What can we do to further the cause of Christ today?  
Even though we may be persecuted, we must speak out for what is right.

4. Generosity of Church  
Acts 4:32-37

Stress the importance of having a good attitude toward giving.  
(Stewardship - II Cor. 9:1-7)

5. Ananias and Sapphira  
Acts 5:1-10

Honesty. Half-truth is not truth. (Dangers of the tongue - James 3)

6. Angel Releases Apostles  
from Prison - Acts 5:17-42

Trust in God. He looks out for His people.

7. Church and Widows  
Acts 6:1-7

Discuss local care for widows in the congregation. Also, discuss the job of a deacon. (I Tim. 3:8-13)

8. Stephen, a Christian  
Martyr - Acts 6:8;  
Acts 7:1-8:1

Help the students to understand that the early Christians faced many hardships. We too must love God enough to give up all. Define and discuss the word "martyr."

9. Phillip and Simon  
Acts 8:5-25

Wrong motives can keep us from God.

10. Phillip and the  
Ethiopian Eunuch  
Acts 8:26-40

Use every opportunity to teach God's Word. This is a good time to stress the plan of salvation.

11. Young Saul (Paul) and  
Saul's Conversion  
Acts 22:3-5; 7:58; 8:1; 9:1-18

God sometimes uses the most unexpected people for His work.  
Discuss the meaning of true conversion.

12. Saul Escapes & Preaches  
Acts 9:19-31

God always protects us when we put Him first.

13. Dorcas - Acts 9:36-43

Helping others and doing good is a part of being a follower of Jesus.

Lesson and Scripture	Applications
14. Cornelius is Converted Peter's Vision & Peter at Cornelius Home-Acts10:1-48	The gospel is for everyone. God is no respecter of persons. We must not be embarrassed or ashamed to share the gospel with all people.
15. Paul's 1 <sup>st</sup> Miss. Journey Church at Antioch Acts11:19-26	Study the journeys of Paul and his companions and to stress that they faced many problems preaching Christ to the Jews <u>and</u> Gentiles. How do we (the church) compare to the church at Antioch?
16. Agabus & the Collection Acts 11:27-30	Most young people earn money for allowance and small jobs. Stress giving as we prosper and the importance of giving cheerfully.
17. Elymas & Sergius Paulus Paul & Barnabas in Lystra And Stoning Paul	(Acts13:1-12; Acts 14:8-28) Don't let clever speakers turn you from God as Lystra did. Also, emphasize that God will never forsake us.
18. Gentiles Freed from Bondage, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Miss. Journey Visiting the Brethen-Acts15	Paul visited brethren to help the new Christians organize their churches. It is God's plan for certain men, elders, to care for the church. Discuss their qualifications.
19. Macedonian Call Acts 16:6-10	Be ready to obey, as Paul was, when asked to do something.
20. Lydia is Converted Acts 16:11-15	Is hospitality a part of the Christian life?
21. Paul & Silas in Prison Acts 16:16-40	God is with us even when bad things happen. Does singing songs to Jesus help us to feel safer or happier? Discuss.
22. Paul, Silas, and Jason in Thessalonica-Acts17:1-9	Talk about the missionaries our congregation supports.
23. Sermon on Mars Hill Acts 17:16-34	Do we ignorantly worship unknown gods? Ask if "things" are more important to us than God or going to worship. Name our "gods."
24. Aquilla and Priscilla Acts 18:1-3, 18-28	Be hospitable and use those opportunities to teach others as Aquilla and Priscilla did.
25. Paul Work in Ephesus & Burning Evil Books Acts 18:23-20:1	Work for God wherever you are. Also, stress that God wants us to get rid of <u>anything</u> that is of Satan and hinders us in our Christian walk.
26. Demetrius & the Riot Acts 19:21-41	Stand up for right. It should be a privilege to suffer for Christ. If we love something more than God, we can also be guilty of having idols.

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## 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Sunday Morning Curriculum 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter- Year 2

Lesson and Scripture	Applications
27. Eutychus & Agabus Acts 20:7-12	Discuss the Power of God and the frailty of man.
28. Paul Speaks on Stairs Acts 21:17-22	We don't have to be afraid to speak out for Christ and His truth.
29. 40 Men Make an Oath Acts 23:12-22	Don't be led by peer pressure or group pressure.
30. Felix – Acts 23:23-35 Acts 24:1-27	“Almost” is not enough.
31. King Agrippa Acts 25, 26	We should count it as glory when persecuted for what we believe.
32. Shipwrecked and Bitten by a Viper Acts 27, 28	It is easy to trust God when everything is going our way, but not so easy when we are facing something difficult. How much are we willing to suffer for the cause of Christ?
33. A Runaway Slave Philemon	Admitting that we have done wrong takes courage. When someone repents, we should forgive them and treat them kindly.
34. Submission to Authority Rom. 13; Eph. 6:1-9	Help the students make a list of those in authority over us. Also, read the following: Matt. 22:15-22; Mk. 12:13-17; and Lk. 20:20-26.
35. The Weak & the Strong Romans 14-15:7	Which are you?
36. Marriage in God's Eyes I Cor. 7; Eph. 5:22-33	Help the class to realize the importance of choosing a Christian mate for a lifetime. (To help them see the seriousness of this decision, review what Jesus tells us concerning adultery and divorce. Matt. 5:27-32.)
37. One Body, Many Parts I Cor. 12	The students should decide on their place in the church.
38. Love – I Cor. 13	Without love, all faith, knowledge, and goodness mean nothing. Is love greater than faith and hope? Why? List what love is, and what it is not.
39. Christian Fellowship II Cor. 6:14-18; 7:1	Hospitality is a great part of the Christian life. How can we grow close to one another if we are far apart physically?

Lesson and Scripture	Applications
40. Idleness--II Thess.3:6-15	"Idleness is the Devil's Workshop." What does this mean?
41. Church Leaders-I Tim.3	How can you prepare yourself to serve the church, as you grow older?
42. Temptation James 1:13-17	Christ was tempted as we are and He never gave in. Talk about ways we can overcome temptation.
43. Faith and Works Heb.11; James 2	Review the "Hero's of Faith." Help the students to realize that faith and trust in God is necessary, but faith must be followed with good works.
44. Dangers of the Tongue James 3	Why is the tongue sometimes called a weapon?
45. The Shepherd John 10:1-18	What kind of sheep are you?
46. Jesus Promises the Holy Spirit-Jn. 14:15-31	Does the Holy Spirit lead us today? Discuss.
47. Second Coming of the Lord -- Matt.24:27-31 I Thess.4:13-18; 5:1-11	Jesus' coming will be personal, bodily, visible, in the clouds, and with the angels. Are you ready? Will this be a happy or sad day?
48. John Sees the Throne And the City of God Rev. 1:9-20; 4:1-11	Talk about Heaven.
49. Seven Churches of Asia Rev.2, 3	Whatever troubles face the church, God will always be stronger and keep it safe.
50. The Final Judgment Matt.25:35-46 Rev.20:11-15; 21:8-27	All who do not obey God will be punished. All who obey will go to Heaven.
51. New Jerusalem I Cor.2:9; Rev.21-22:5	We must not let anything stop us from doing God's work. Even though life may be difficult, we will be rewarded in Heaven.
