**Something New on the Horizon**

In reaction to the title, you may be thinking, "Yes, there is something new on the horizon, and it's called the New Year." Well, that's true, but there's more. Beginning in January 2017, Pulaski Street Church of Christ will be doing something new, and my prayer is that this something new will spiritually benefit this church family and potentially the community as well.

Soon after arriving back in Lawrenceburg to preach for this wonderful congregation, I began working on a four-year adult Bible curriculum. The curriculum covers every book of the Bible and provides an array of topical studies, both doctrinal and practical, that will inform, develop, and challenge believers. Each year of this four-year curriculum is broken down into four quarters. Each quarter is comprised of five classes: three on Sunday mornings at 9:30 a.m. and two on Wednesday nights at 7:00 p.m. It would take a conscientious Bible student over ten years to take every course in this curriculum. As with anything developed by a human being, it is certainly not flawless. Changes to the curriculum are sure to occur over time, but I am confident that this curriculum provides a structured and balanced approach to learning about God and His will, becoming more Christ-like, and being equipped to share our faith with others.

Christianity is a taught religion. Jesus taught (Mark 1:38-39; Matt. 13:54). The apostles taught (Acts 4:2; 5:42; 20:20). Evangelists or preachers taught (Acts 18:24-26; 1 Tim. 4:11-13; 5:17). People cannot devote themselves to something or practice something that they do not know, understand, or appreciate. Becoming and being a disciple of Jesus Christ inevitably involves teaching and learning (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 8:26-39; 1 Tim. 4:11-16; 2 Tim. 2:1-2). The textbook is the Bible. Please commit yourself to taking advantage of this new adult Bible curriculum. You won't regret it.

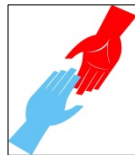
