**Spiritual Resolutions**

Ahh, it's begun. Folks are doing their best to make good on their resolutions for 2018. There's a guy who has started exercising and counting calories to lose weight. There's another guy stepping up his core workouts in hopes of moving from a six-pack to an eight-pack. There's a girl who has begun training to run her first half-marathon. There's a couple who has started eating healthier to prevent or improve various health issues. There's a thirty-year-old woman who has resolved to go back to school. There's a forty-year-old husband and father who has started making improvements to his home.

Change can be good . . . really good, but you'll notice that all of the above changes address a person's physical or material well-being. Those are the kind of New Year's resolutions that people usually make, but spiritual resolutions should not be overlooked. They are, after all, more important (cf. 1 Tim. 4:7-8).

For Christians, spirituality is defined by Scripture, and there's an inner self, not just an outer self, that needs to be nurtured and strengthened (2 Cor. 4:16). Below is a list of possible spiritual resolutions that you could make, if you haven't already:

- Make it a priority to attend every scheduled assembly of your brothers and sisters in Christ.
- Get meaningfully involved in some capacity of your congregation's work.
- Make reading and studying Scripture a daily endeavor (Acts 17:11).
- Start keeping a daily log of those people for whom you are praying.
- Cancel any and all "debts," and start keeping short accounts (Eph. 4:26-27, 31-32).
- Begin focusing on what you do have rather than on what you don't have.
- Stop worrying so much and start standing on God's promises (Matt. 6:25-34).
- Resolve to quit a sinful habit or practice that has mastered you for far too long and marred your Christian example.

This list is obviously not exhaustive, but perhaps it got you thinking on the right track. What spiritual resolution(s) do you need to make? Better yet, what spiritual resolution will turn into a spiritual realization for you in 2018?
