**Atonement**

Atonement is about restoring humanity's relationship with God. It's about bringing God and man back into fellowship with one another: AT-ONE-MENT. At the heart of atonement—the most crucial thing—is the violent, voluntary, vicarious, and victorious crucifixion of Jesus Christ. In order to help us understand and appreciate what Christ accomplished at the cross, the NT writers provide us with several images.

**Sacrifice (Heb. 9:23-28).** We deserved to *die* as the penalty for sin. To pay the penalty of death that we deserved because of our sins, Christ died as a sacrifice for us. He took our place. He bore the punishment and suffered the penalty that we rightfully deserved.

**Redemption (Matt. 20:28; Mark 10:45; 1 Pet. 1:18-19).** We were *in bondage* to sin and to the kingdom of Satan. Thus, we needed someone to “redeem” us out of that bondage. When we speak of redemption, the idea of a “ransom” comes into view. A ransom is the price paid to redeem someone from bondage and captivity. The death of Christ is viewed as the precious payment to redeem us from bondage.

**Propitiation (Rom. 3:25; Heb. 2:17; 1 John 2:2; 4:10).** We deserved to *bear God's wrath* because of our sin, but Christ died to placate, satisfy, or turn away God's wrath. Christ became the object of God's wrath, so that we wouldn't have to be.

**Reconciliation (Rom. 5:6-11; 2 Cor. 5:18; Eph. 2:13-16; Col. 1:19-20).** We were *separated* from God by our sins. To overcome alienation from God, we needed someone to make reconciliation possible by providing a way for us to make peace with God. Christ's death accomplished just that.

**Justification (Rom. 3:26).** We were *legally condemned* because of sin. Yet, because of Christ's death and our obedient faith, we can stand justified before God.

Throughout history, there has been a tendency among theologians to elevate a NT image of the atonement above all others; however, the NT atonement-images appear to be all-inclusive and interrelated. I would argue that the atonement is larger than any one image; consequently, one image should not be elevated above the others. The variety of images underscores the richness and inexhaustible depth of Jesus' atonement-producing death.
