**You Can't Grow Alone**

Those of us who desire to be pleasing to God should desire to grow spiritually. Indeed, we should seek to become as much like Jesus Christ as we possibly can (2 Cor. 3:18; Col. 1:28-29). However, we must realize that spiritual growth is not something that we can accomplish on our own.

During the course of our lives, we have all needed help in accomplishing something or completing some task, e.g., preparing for a test, preparing taxes, moving, renovating a home, repairing a car, raising children, etc. When it comes to spiritual growth and becoming the people that God wants us to be, we all need help. More specifically, we need certain people in our lives to help us become more like Christ.

There are two people in particular that we need in our lives to help us grow. First, we need a Nathan. In 2 Samuel 12:1-15, Nathan rebukes David for his sin with Bathsheba. Like David, we need a friend who will call us out and correct us. Solomon wrote, "Faithful are the wounds of a friend; profuse are the kisses of an enemy" (Prov. 27:6). We need true friends, not flatterers. Second, we need a Barnabas. In Acts 4:36, the apostles nicknamed a man "Barnabas," meaning "Son of Encouragement," evidently because of the encouragement he provided them and others. This man later helped Paul become accepted by the apostles in Jerusalem (Acts 9:26-30), and he even accompanied Paul on his first missionary journey (Acts 11:19-31; 13—15). Like Paul, we need a friend who will stand by our side through thick and thin and provide us with encouragement along the way.

If there is one "place" where we should be able to find a host of Nathans and Barnabases, it is Christ's church. This is the case because of what God expects His people, i.e. the church, to do for one another. God's people are not only to rebuke, discipline, and admonish one another (cf. Matt. 18:15-16; Luke 17:3; Rom. 15:14; Gal. 6:1-2; Col. 3:16; 2 Thess. 3:13-15; 1 Tim. 5:20), but they are also to encourage one another (cf. 1 Thess. 4:18; 5:9-11, 14; Heb. 3:13; 10:24-25). As members of Christ's church, we not only need a Nathan and a Barnabas in our lives to help us grow, but we also need to be a Nathan and a Barnabas to others to help them grow.
