Forgetfulness

All throughout the Old Testament, certain things were done and certain steps were taken to ensure that God's people would remember God's power, provisions, and promises. We find feasts and festivals filling up the Jewish calendar. We also find monuments and memorials dotting Jewish history. God knew that by remembering the past, His people could be buoyed in the present and equipped for the future. Indeed, forgetfulness is one of the greatest enemies of faith.

You might recall that after Israel crossed the Jordan, God commanded Joshua to make sure that a man from each tribe took a stone from the middle of the Jordan to be used in constructing a memorial. Getting through the river wasn't the end of it all; they had to remember what happened there. Those twelve stones were to serve as visual aids to that end. Not only were those who actually crossed the Jordan that day instructed never to forget, but they were to teach their children and their children's children to remember as well. Joshua says, "When your children ask in time to come, 'What do those stones mean to you?' then you shall tell them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it passed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. So these stones shall be to the people of Israel a memorial forever" (Josh. 4:7; cf. 4:21-22).

Obviously, the pattern of remembering carries over into the Lord's church today in the Lord's Supper (Luke 22:14-20; 1 Cor. 11:23-26). Even our children might whisper to us as we partake of the Lord's Supper: "Daddy, what does that mean? Mama, what are you doing?" And we can whisper our reasons back to them. Why this remembrance? Because we cannot afford to forget that on the cross Jesus Christ, the Son of God, soaked up the wrath of God for our sins so that we might have our sins forgiven and wait expectantly for His return. Forgetfulness incites faithlessness; remembrance inspires faithfulness.
