Who Are You?

Jesus told a Samaritan woman on one occasion that God is seeking “true worshipers” (John 4:23). Are you a true worshiper? What follows should help you determine that.

The Neither-Nors. Atheists, skeptics, agnostics, humanists, Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists, and even some professing Christians fall into this camp (cf. Rom. 1:18ff; Matt. 7:21-23; John 14:6; 2 Thess. 1:8-9). These folks aren’t interested in worshiping God on Sundays or serving Him through the week. Moreover, neither their external life (i.e. actions) nor their internal life (i.e. attitudes) honors God. Their motto could be “Don’t go to church; don’t be the church.”

The Either-Ors. Those in this camp are either all in on Sunday but missing through the rest of the week, or they are all in Monday through Saturday but missing on Sunday. Those in the first category are Sunday-only Christians in the strictest sense. In their minds, as long as they punch the ticket on Sunday morning, then they are free to live how they want to the rest of the week. For them, Jesus is reversible. On Sundays, they put him on, but they turn him inside out Monday through Saturday. They pay lip service to God, but their hearts are far from God (Matt. 15:8). Their motto could be “Just go to church; don’t be the church.”

Those in the second category are among an increasing number of people who want Jesus but not the church. They want more Jesus and less religion. In their minds, corporate worship is a relic of the past, if not a liability. They are disgusted with the idea of “organized religion.” They emphasize a personal relationship with Jesus to the exclusion of any meaningful involvement in the worship and work of a local church. This is not to say that they do not engage in any good works, but they do remain aloof from a local congregation. Their motto could be: “Don’t go to church; just be the church.”

The Both-Ands. These are the Christians who understand that their worship on Sundays is connected to their lifestyle on Mondays through Saturdays, and vice versa. In their estimation, not only should one go to church, i.e., worship alongside of fellow Christians in a local church (Heb. 10:24-25), but that person should also seek to be the church, i.e., reflect a life devoted wholly to Christ (Rom. 12:1-2). They cherish both the “head,” i.e., the Christ, and the “body,” i.e., the church (Eph. 1:22-23). They draw near to God with both their lips and their hearts. Their motto could be “Go to church; be the church.”

So, who are you? Are you a “neither-nor,” an “either-or,” or a “both-and.” Only the latter category represents the “true worshipers” that God is seeking.
