The Pornography Problem

Research clearly shows that pornography use is on the rise and is a common occurrence in our society. Today, roughly 2.5 million people visit the world's most popular porn sites every 60 seconds. More than 28,000 users collectively visit porn sites every second. The top three porn sites alone, led by Pornhub, generate 135,000 new visits in a minute. Approximately 35% of search engine requests are related to pornography. An estimated 40 million Americans regularly visit porn sites. The porn industry worldwide is currently generating about 100 billion dollars a year!

- **Anonymity**. The barriers to sexually explicit material that once existed have disappeared, as the Internet has become a ubiquitous service. Before the Internet, access to this type of material was challenging, and keeping things anonymous was practically impossible. Purchasing or viewing this kind of material once required a visit to a bookstore, video store, adult store, or movie theater. That alone served as a barrier to most people. Now, you can access pornographic material without showing your face, giving your name, or even telling your age.
- have online access. Our smartphones are really nothing more than handheld computers.
- either cheap or free.

While some erroneously argue that viewing pornography is good and beneficial, right-thinking people know better. Not only can pornography be as addictive as any drug, but it also assaults the dignity and worth of human beings, especially women. Pornography use can also arrest sexual fulfillment in marriage, and not a few marriages have been destroyed by it. Moreover, many sexual crimes against women and children find an "ancestor" in pornography use.
