A Good Investment

Speaking kind words is an investment that costs us virtually nothing, but the return on that investment is oftentimes incalculable. It’s hard to overestimate what can happen when you invest a kind word into someone else’s emotional account. It doesn’t require much of you, and when you take the little time that it takes to share something kind with others, it can change the course of their day and maybe even their lives. Mark Twain once said, “I can go two months on a good compliment.” Most of us keep kind words with us for a while. Kind words are incredibly efficient fuel for our spirits. We can keep those kind words in our tank, and they can fuel us for miles and miles. Don’t ever underestimate the power of an encouraging word.

I usually spend some time reflecting after every sermon I preach. Sometimes right after I’ve said the last word, I get this feeling in the pit of my stomach that I don’t like. It’s a feeling that things didn’t quite come together like I wanted. It is a feeling that tends to create some self-doubt and results in asking myself questions like, “Did I just waste everyone’s time in preaching that sermon? Why did I think that sermon was worth preaching?” However, after the closing prayer, one or two or many of you will say a few kind words to me. It changes my mood, and those kind words continue to fuel me through the next week as I work on my lessons.

That’s what kind words can do. They can change the direction of someone’s day. Kind words stay with people, continuing to encourage them many days beyond the day that we voiced them. We all can encourage other people. We all can speak “upwords” that will make the difference in somebody’s day, month, year, or even life. But will we do it? Will we be generous with our praise and kind words for others? Will we make that small investment and see the great rewards that it will bring?
