## Teen Class Curriculum 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter- Year 2

Lesson	Scripture	Applications
1. Judas' Promise	Matt.26:1-5,14-16 Luke 22:1-6	The love of money causes only heartache.
2. The Last Supper	Matt.26:17-29	When Christians take communion, everyone should be quiet and reverent. We are remembering Jesus' body, bloodshed and His death.
3. Garden of Gethsemane	Luke 22:39-46	Jesus went through great anguish in the garden because He loves us and He wanted to do His Father's will. Discuss total sacrifice.
4. Peter Denies Christ	Matt.26:69-75	We must try and stay true to Christ under all circumstances.
5. Crucifixion	Luke 23: 26-55	Discuss Christ's pain and suffering in depth. He did this out of the great love he has for us.
6. Resurrection	Luke 24:13-44	The resurrection is an event that strengthens our hope of life after death.
7. Appearances of Jesus The Great Catch of Fish	Luke 24:1-2 John 21	Proof that Jesus arose and lives. Talk about the special time spent with His disciples before His ascension.
8. The Great Commission and the Ascension	Matt.28:16-20 Mark 16:15-20 Luke 24:45-51 Acts 1:9-11	We must tell the good news until Jesus returns. Jesus is in Heaven now, watching over us. We have the promise that we too, can live with Him in Heaven if we are obedient.
9. Day of Pentecost	Acts 2	The church is made up of Christians who are striving to obey God's will. Stress - it is through the Word that God's Spirit guides us today.
10. Lame Man at Gate	Acts 3:1-10	Stress the Power of God.
11. The Church Increases Annas & Caiphas Speak To Peter and John	Acts 3:11-26 Acts 4:1-22	Even though we may be persecuted, we must speak out for what is right.
12. Generosity of Church	Acts 4:32-37	Stress the importance of having a good attitude toward giving. (Stewardship - IICor.9:1-7)
13. Ananias and Sapphira	Acts 5:1-10	Honesty. Half-truth is not truth. (Dangers of the tongue - James 3)

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## Teen Class Curriculum 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter- Year 2

Lesson	Scripture	Applications
14. Angel Releases Apostles from Prison	Acts 5:17-42	Trust in God. He looks out for His people.
15. Church and Widows	Acts 6:1-7	Discuss local care for widows in the congregation. Also, discuss the job of a deacon. (I Tim.3:8-13)
16. Stephen, A Christian Martyr	Acts 6:8 Acts 7:1-8:1	Help the children to understand that the early Christians faced many hardships. We too must love God enough to give up all. Define "Martyr."
17. Philip and Simon	Acts 8:5-25	Wrong motives can keep us from God.
18. Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch	Acts 8:26-40	Use every opportunity to teach God's Word. This is a good time to stress the plan of salvation.
19. Young Saul (Paul) Saul's Conversion	Acts 22:3-5; 7:58 Acts 8:1-3; 9:1-18	God sometimes uses the most unexpected people for His work.
20. Saul Escapes & Preaches	Acts 9:19-31	God always protects us when we put Him first.
21. Dorcas	Acts 9:36-43	Helping others and doing good is part of being a follower of Jesus.
22. Cornelius is Converted, Peter's Vision and Peter at Cornelius' Home	Acts 10:1-8 Acts 10:9-23 Acts 10:24-48	The gospel is for everyone. God is no respecter of persons. We must not be embarrassed or ashamed to share the gospel with all people.
23. Paul Becomes a Missionary - 1 <sup>st</sup> Journey	Acts 11:19-26	Study the journeys of Paul and his companions and to stress that they faced many problems preaching Christ to the Jews and Gentiles.
24. Agabus & the Collection	Acts 11:27-30	Learning to give cheerfully even now as young people.
25. An Angel Releases Peter From Prison	Acts 12:1-19	We should thank God for His great love and constant care. Stress the importance of prayer.
26. Elymas & Sergius Paulas & Paul & Barnabas in Lystra & Stoning Paul	Acts 13:1-12 Acts 14:8-28	Don't let clever speakers turn you from God as Lystra did. Also, emphasize that God will never forsake us.

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## Teen Class Curriculum 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter- Year 2

Lesson	Scripture	Applications
27. 2 <sup>nd</sup> Missionary Journey – Visiting the Brethren	Acts 15	Discuss that Paul visited brethren to help the new Christians organize their churches.
28. Church Leaders	I Tim.3; Titus 1	It is part of God's plan for certain men, elders, to care for the church. Discuss their qualifications.
29. Timothy, the Missionary	Acts 16:1-3 II Tim.1:1-15; II Tim.3:14-17	Emphasize that as young people, like Timothy was, we should strive to have a clear understanding of God's Word and obey it.
30. Macedonian Call	Acts 16:6-10	Be ready to obey when asked to do something, as Paul was to obey God.
31. Lydia is Converted	Acts 16:11-15	Hospitality is a great part of the Christian life.
32. Paul, Silas, and the Phillipian Jailer	Acts 16:16-40	God is with us even when bad things happen. Singing songs to Jesus can help us to be happy.
33. Paul, Silas, and Jason in Thessalonica	Acts 17:1-9	Discuss missionaries our congregation supports.
34. Sermon in Athens (Mars Hill)	Acts 17:16-34	Do we ignorantly worship unknown gods? Ask if "things" are more important to us than God or going to worship. (Entertainment, friends, etc...)
35. The Lord Speaks to Paul in a Vision	Acts 18:1-18	You cannot spread God's Word by keeping quiet.
36. Aquilla and Priscilla	Acts 18:1-3, 18-28	Be hospitable and teach others as Aquilla and Priscilla did.
37. Paul's Work in Ephesus and Burning Evil Books	Acts 18:23-20:1	Work for God wherever we are. Also, stress that God wants us to get rid of <u>anything</u> that is of Satan and hinders us in our Christian walk.
38. Demetrius and the Riot	Acts 19:21-41	Stand up for right. It should be a privilege to suffer for Christ. If we love something more than God, we can also be guilty of having idols.
39. Eutychus & Agabus	Acts 20:7-12	Discuss the Power of God; frailty of man.

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## Teen Class Curriculum 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter- Year 2

Lesson	Scripture	Applications
40. Farewell to Ephesus	Acts 20:13-38	Live faithfully even if persecuted by friends.
41. 40 Men Make an Oath	Acts 23:12-22	Don't be led by peer pressure or group pressure.
42. Felix	Acts 23:23-35;24:1-27	"Almost" is not enough.
43. King Agrippa	Acts 25, 26	We should count it as glory when persecuted for what we believe.
44. Shipwrecked and Bitten by a Viper	Acts 27, 28	It is easy to trust God when everything is going our way, but not so easy when we are facing something difficult. How much are we willing to suffer for the cause of Christ?
45. A Runaway Slave	Philemon	It takes courage to admit that you have done wrong. When someone repents, we should forgive them and treat them kindly.
46. Fruits of the Spirit	Gal. 5:22-26	Talk about the meaning of each. Stress, as Jesus' followers we will act and think differently as we allow these "fruits of the spirit" to live within us.
47. Faith and Works	Heb.11; James 2	Faith and trust in God is necessary, but faith must be followed with good works.
48. John Sees the Throne and City of God	Rev.1:9-20; 4:1-14	Talk about Heaven
49. The Seven Churches Of Asia	Rev. 2, 3	Whatever troubles face the church, God will always be stronger and keep it safe.
50. Second Coming of Jesus	Matt.24:27-31 Luke 21:25-28 II Pet.3:10	From the scriptures we learn that Jesus' coming will be personal, bodily, visible, in the clouds, and with the angels.
51. The Final Judgment	Matt.25:35-46 Rev.20:11-15;21:8-27	All who do not obey God will be punished. All who obey will go to Heaven.
52. New Jerusalem	I Cor. 2:9 Rev. 21-22:5	We should not let anything stop us from doing God's work. Even though life may be difficult, we will be rewarded in Heaven.
