Helping the Hurting

In His ministry, Jesus had compassion on hurting people (Matt. 4:23-25; 9:35). Their hurts were physical, from sickness to disease to demon-possession. And those hurts mattered to Jesus. His heart went out to them. He felt deeply for them. And He took action. Jesus helped the hurting. You and I need to approach people the same way Jesus did, sensitive to the hurts they harbor. The hurts we encounter may be physical, social, or emotional.

In my ministry at Greenback and here at Pulaski Street, I have encountered a host of people who were hurting for one reason or another. During my ministry in Greenback, I remember a lady by the name of Georgette. She had lost her 20-something-year-old-son to cancer about a year prior. The hurt she was feeling when we met was just as real a year later as the day she lost her boy. We met week after week, so that she could tell me the story of her son's excruciatingly slow demise.

I remember a man by the name of Jerry. We baptized him in 2007 during a mission campaign that was spearheaded by members of the Mount Juliet Church of Christ. I went to his house every week for months to study the Bible with him. He had a lung disease that made it hard for him to breathe. He was essentially confined to his home.

I remember a guy named Tim who lived and worked with a family that lived down the road from the church building in Greenback. From the age of 19 to the age of 34, he had been battling an addiction to cocaine. His home life had been less than stellar, and he turned to that stuff to escape the hurt, only to step into another world of hurt.

Since coming to Pulaski Street, I have met a lot of hurting people. I remember J.V. I had been here a little over a month, and we met here at the building. Not only had he been battling lung cancer for about eight months, but he was also struggling with the fact that he and his son were not on speaking terms. J.V. was baptized the day I met him, Tuesday, May 12, and he passed away eight days later on Wednesday, May 20.

Now, unlike Jesus, we are limited in what we can do for these hurting people. I could not bring Georgette's son back from the dead. I could not restore Jerry's lungs to their full vitality. I could not remove Tim's addiction to cocaine. I could neither cure J.V.'s cancer nor reconcile him to his son. But I could care. I could show sympathy. I could pray.

As Christians, we cannot be callous and unfeeling to people's hurts. We must open our hearts to them. We live in a world of hurting people. Most of the people we meet are hurting in one way or another, and those of us who are Christians have got to enter into their pain and seek to redeem it by pointing them to Jesus, the Great Physician.
