How to Respond to an Awesome God

Part One

What Job says in Job 42:1-6 is much briefer than what he said before God began speaking out of the whirlwind in Job 38, but it furnishes us with a really good idea of how you and I should respond to an awesome God. Over the course of three articles, I want to point out three things that Job does as he finds himself confronted by the beauty, majesty, grandeur, power, and wisdom of God. I recommend that Job's response should be our response to the God who inspires awe.

The first aspect of our response to an awesome God is *praise*. We should praise God. Job 42:2 is Job praising God. Job is probably not grinning from ear to ear in this moment of praise, but all praise doesn't come from moments like that. Praise simply comes when we are confronted with something praiseworthy, and various emotions may be present at that moment. For Job, his praise was bordering on terror, but his response, nonetheless, was an expression of praise: "God, let me tell you about you. Let me tell you what is amazing about you. Let me tell you what I am feeling as I am confronted with the wonder of you right now." That's what we do when we praise God.

That's what you read in the Psalms. You find a host of people thinking out loud about God. "God, here is what I know about you. Here is what I am confronted with in this moment concerning your nature that is so worthy of praise and adoration." Take a moment and read Psalm 113. If we want to respond appropriately to an awesome God, we should respond in praise. Some of that praise may be smiling praise, and some of that praise may be trembling praise.

We respond to this praiseworthy God by praising Him, and it's quite possible that you and I don't praise God enough. Our prayers often consist more of petition than praise. I think we all could use a shot in the arm when it comes to our praise. Our praise of God should not be confined to our public gatherings. As we are confronted with the grandeur of God throughout the week, we should take the time to praise him. Make it a practice to start your prayers with the words "God, you are _____." This is a good way to begin, because it reminds us of why we are praying to God in the first place. He is the One who made all we see and don't see and who redeemed us from our sins. There is no one like Him. He is the One who can do anything He wants. He is the One whose purposes cannot be thwarted, and so, we praise Him.
